Pre-Entry Forms and 2025 Fairbooks are ready for PICK UP at the office!

June 15 County Fair Deadline

Submit all paperwork to the Extension Office by Friday, June 13 or postmarked by June 15 to exhibit at the Madison County Fair!

Drop off locations will be available on Friday, June 13 in Battle Creek and Newman Grove. Submit the following paperwork to the Extension Office at 1305 S. 13th St. Norfolk, NE 68701 by Friday, June 13 by 5:00 p.m. if possible.

So, what are Pre-entry forms?

Pre-entry forms are ready and are needed for our data entry system that we use for the county fair. These help us know what projects you are bringing to the county fair. You will use a fair book and complete the form with the projects and classes your 4-H member will be completing for judging. They were emailed to families from Betty (on 4/2/25) where you may fill out a blank form from April's newsletter OR the Excel version!

For example, if they are sewing a patchwork pillow for the fair they would enroll in the following:

- Department C, Division 901, Class 904 Pillow
- Then, if your 4-H member decides to model their pillow for our 4-H Fashion Show, you would also need to include that as well on the form.
- Department C, Division 410, Class 901 Sewing for Fun Modeling

What are the Fashion Show Pre-entry forms?

These forms are included with your pre-entries if you enrolled in a textiles project. These forms are due back to the office so we can prepare the judges books, narrations, and program order for judging day and for the fashion show.

IMPORTANT

Livestock ID Information

Available at Extension Office:

- · Ear tags required for county-only beef, sheep, goats, swine, bucket calves
- EID Tags will be required for market, commercial (< or tattoo), feeders, and swine attending the State Fair.

DNA – breeding livestock and feeder calves will now be required to submit DNA sample/envelopes for state fair

- · Tattoos required for registered breeding beef or and ID type that is accepted by the breed association attending the State Fair or EID Tags/tattoo for commercial breeding beef attending state fair. Breeding beef only attending the county fair can either have a county ear tag and / or tattoo.
- · Registered breeding heifers need their registration papers for check-in at the County and State fair.
- · Rabbits are required to be tattooed.
- · County-only tags: \$1.00
- · EID tags (State Fair): \$1.00
- · All sheep and goats require scrapie tags for County and State Fair.

 All market & breeding sheep and goats must have a scrapie tag. All market hogs and market beef must have an 840 EID tag and breeding heifers must have a tattoo and DNA sample.

DNA Envelopes for NE State Fair

• DNA envelopes will be \$7.00 per envelope. All breeding nominations will be \$2.00 per online entry. Exhibitors will be able to dual nominate an animal as breeding and market if selected and paid for in Show Stock Manager. Families will now receive a receipt that they have entered in a breeding nomination.

Submitting Animal Information into Show Stock Manager Livestock Database

• Exhibitors will be responsible for submitting their animal information into the www.showstockmgr.com website prior to the nomination deadlines. Completed DNA forms are due to our office by June 15th. (we will validate and submit these for you) Once the information is in the database and has been validated by the Extension Educator, it will then be available for exhibitors to make State Fair entries. Any animal entry not in the database or have DNA submitted will not be considered nominated and eligible for State Fair.


