### Northeast Nebraska Extension Master Gardener Volunteer Plant Fair committee meeting

Kathy Duvall reported that perennial plants have been ordered. Order amount was reduced by \$1,000 per Blue Bird Nursery recommendation since we sold fewer plants last year. This was related to tornado warning on Friday evening of plant fair. Discussion was held regarding possibility of reducing prices on Saturday of plant fair to sell more plants and avoid restocking fee. Will discuss at next meeting.

<u>Advertising</u> visibility to advertise for our plant fair.

Pam Foltz will create a permission form to be signed by property representatives where banners are placed.

Robin Jones who has been leading advertising for the plant fair is ill and hospitalized. We wish her the best with her recovery. Mary Lux volunteered to contact radio stations to see if is feasible to arrange live broadcasts at plant fair.

Diane Lukens proposed having an organization sponsor the plant fair. She also suggested having Midwest Bank advertise the plant fair on their digital sign outside the bank.

Vendors-

Pam Foltz reported she has e-mailed 146 prospective vendors and has received few responses. One vendor expressed concern that we need to find a way to increase attendance at the plant fair.

<u>Café</u>-

Mary Lux reported the cost of pop and ground beef has increased. Mary passed around a signup sheet for members to indicate if they wish to donate a dozen bars or pay \$10.
