### FARM PRODUCTS

Exhibits should be selected for type, uniformity, quality, and maturity. Do not select the large overgrown specimens, not the small ones, but choose a medium size that shows adaptation to the community and suitable for market purposes.

The following rules will govern the exhibits:

1. Threshed grain will be exhibited in open containers.
2. All exhibits must be raised by the exhibitor and no limit to entering different varieties.
3. All exhibits must be true to entry as to variety and classification or otherwise they may be changed by the judge or superintendent.
4. Superintendents may add classes if necessary.

### THRESHED GRAIN AND SEEDS

**1. Any grain or grass seed.** Must list variety (one quart)

**2. Any corn seed.** Must list variety (one pint)

### CORN

**1. 10 ears** from last year's crop. Any variety corn including miniature and decorative varieties. No limit to varieties.

### TALLEST/SMALLEST CORN/SUNFLOWER

Premiums will be paid for the tallest stalks of corn with ear and without ear exhibited. Stalks must be shown green, with roots bagged. Stalks must be grown by exhibitor. Stalks will be measured from tip of tassel to bottom of first joint above roots.

- 1. Tallest Corn Stalk with Ears**
- 2. Tallest Corn Stalk w/o Ears**
- 3. Tallest Sunflower Stalk**
- 4. Smallest Corn Stalk**

### GRAIN SHEAVES

**Small grain sheaves** should be three inches in diameter and neatly bound with leaves stripped off. Must be a product of the current season. Any grain variety.

### FORAGE SHEAVES

**Forage sheaves** should be at least 3 inches in diameter, neatly bound, and will be scored on leafiness, color, and overall quality of forage. Sheaves of millet and soybeans shall be of sufficient maturity to show head or seed characteristics. Any grass, grain, or alfalfa.

### FRUIT

All entries must be clean, they shall be free from scab, blotch, and other diseases. They shall be uniform in size, shape, and color. Number to exhibit is shown in parentheses

**1. All Apples** (4 per variety)

**2. All Fruit** (4 per variety)

**3. All Grapes and Berries** (2 bunches)

**4. New crop nuts** (6 per variety)

**5. Shelled nuts, sunflower seed, and dry beans** (1 pint)
