- Tie Breaker will be based on the submissions and completeness of your Saline County 4-H Achievement & Activity Record. While the 4-H Achievement & Activity Record is not required to receive your fair premium money, IT IS required to be submitted with this application.
- This application should have dates and details of activities, involvement, and projects from the CURRENT 4-H Year ONLY. Activities, involvement, and projects from prior years will not be accepted.
- Attached documentation/confirmation of registration/copy of receipt for any Nebraska 4-H sponsored event you attend such a Nebraska 4-H Camp, PASE, Winners Unlimited Livestock Judging Camp, State Horse Show, etc.
- ALL ENTERED INFORMATION IN THIS APPLICATION IS SUBJECT TO VERIFICATION WITH YOUR CLUB LEADER(S) AND THE EXTENSION OFFICE RECORDS. REPORTED TOTALS WILL BE CHECKED FOR ACCURACY. MAXIMUM OF 100 POINTS.
