Once the screening process is complete, your information will be made available to county Extension offices and State Fair 4-H superintendents.

Those interested in hiring you to judge will contact you directly. The 2026 registration is currently open and close on September 30, 2025. Any names submitted after September 30, 2025, will be added to the list of interested individuals for the 2027 hiring.
