

Sample showmanship script.

My name is _____ and my exhibitor number is _____.

Today I am showing a Dutch buck. This rabbit was born in March 20___. For Jr. Bucks minimum weight is 1 3/4 pounds, and ideal weight is 4 1/2 pounds for a Dutch.

The color portions of the Dutch are from the circle made by the saddle & undercut, on the stops around the head & markings on the face. The remainder is white. Dutch colors are black, blue, chocolate, gray, steel, and tortoise.

This is the front view of my rabbit. The ears are carried erect and set close together on the head. There are no earmites, the left ear also has the registration tattoo which is _____. The nose is clear with no discharge. The eyes are clear, bright and bold. The head is well rounded and full, sets close to the shoulders.

The right view of my rabbit shows the body is short and close coupled. Hindquarters are to be smooth, well rounded and slightly deeper & wider than the shoulders.

This is the rear view, the rump is well rounded, the tail is straight.

Here is the left side view of my rabbit, it is well rounded and full all the way down. The Dutch should maintain a close coupled, well rounded appearance.

The teeth are not broken or missing. The body is free of blemishes or lumps on the belly or under the chin.

The front legs are straight, there are 4 toenails & one dewclaw. The hocks are not sore. The back legs are straight with 4 toenails on each foot and hocks are not sore. A disqualification of the Dutch is if the toenail is colored.

The sex of my rabbit is a buck.

The fur is flyback and it is dense and short.
