What is a premise ID?

-A premises identification number (PIN) is a unique code that is permanently assigned to a single physical location. A premise ID is administered by each State and allows animal health officials to quickly and precisely identify where animals are located in the event of an animal health or food safety emergency.

USDA Scrapies Tag Information

- Market Sheep, Breeding Sheep, Market Goats, Breeding Goats need USDA scrapies tags for identification for 4-H and State Fair.
 - **Scrapie Control and Eradication Regulations** - The Scrapie Control and Eradication Regulations became effective on September 30, 2005.
