**Transportation:** Each camper is responsible for their own transportation to and from camp. A list of campers from Antelope County can be found on the back to aid in carpooling.

**Medications:** All medications should be in a clear zip lock bag clearly marked with your name, dosage, etc. and given to staff at the check-in table.

**Reminder FOR 2024:** Please bring a reusable water bottle labeled with your name. You can also bring money for snacks at the pool if you would like.
