

Antelope County Outstanding 4-H Member Scholarship Application

Application Criteria:

- 1. Applicant must be a current High School senior or College Freshman.
- 2. Applicant must be an active member in the Antelope County 4-H program. Therefore, the applicant must not be older than 18 years of age on January 1 of the current calendar year.
- 3. Application must be completed and turned into Nebraska Extension in Antelope County by March 17 of the current calendar year. After submission, applications will not be returned.
- 4. Applicant may only be awarded the scholarship once, but may reapply if still meets criteria and has not received it.

Judging Criteria:

Antelope County 4-H Council will appoint a scholarship committee and the scholarships will be decided by that committee.

Scholarship Information:

- 1. Two \$750 scholarships will be awarded, one boy and one girl, in the name of Antelope County Outstanding Boy and Antelope County Outstanding Girl. In the event that there are not one boy and one girl applicants, two boys or two girls may be so awarded.
- 2. Scholarships will be awarded at the Award Ceremony the Sunday of Antelope County Fair.
- 3. Scholarship money will be awarded after the enrollment of the awardee's second semester of Freshman year. Awardee needs to present a copy of the class schedule for second semester class to the Nebraska Extension in Antelope County and will be awarded a check at that time.
- 4. Scholarship monies will be directed to the scholarship winner.
