

Northeast Community College Livestock Classic

Sponsored by the NECC Livestock Judging Team, held in the Chuck M. Pohlman Ag Complex

Friday and Saturday, November 23rd & 24th, 2018. Sanctioning of the show with the Jr Nebraska Cattlemen is pending

The show will be separated into two days, with the Breeding Heifers showing on Friday, November 23rd and the Market Animals on Saturday, November 24th.

- Doors open at 2:00pm on Thursday
- Breeding Heifer check-in from 7:00pm – 9:00pm on Thursday, and 8:00am – 10:00am Friday.
- Show will begin at 10:30 on Friday with showmanship, breed classes to follow
- Market Animal check-in will be from 7:00 pm – 9:00pm on Friday and 7:30am – 9:30am on Saturday.
- Show will begin at 10:00 am on Saturday with showmanship, market heifer and steer classes to follow.

Exhibitors may show in showmanship classes on both days as long as they are exhibiting cattle both days. Animals may be fitted for showmanship. A peewee showmanship class will also be held each day. The show is open to all 4-H, FFA, or JR Breed Association exhibitors.

Stall space has been a concern in the past; this is part of the reason for continuing to have a two day show. Stalls will be assigned for pre-entered animals – please mail your entries early to insure your stalling preference! No stalls will be assigned for entries postmarked prior to Friday, November 16 or received by Monday, November 19.

See attached flyer for additional show information. Note that breeding heifers and market steers must meet respective registration requirements. Breeding heifers and market steers must have papers, sale catalog, or bill of sale from previous owner verifying registration to show in breed classes. If this information is not presented, the breeding heifer or market steer will show in the commercial heifer or crossbred steer class. Also, exhibitors shall not add materials, natural or synthetic, which extend body shapes beyond normal limits. No “butt fans” will be allowed in the Ag Complex. Exhibitors are required to show their own animals in the Showmanship classes. Cash prizes will be awarded for Supreme Breeding Heifers and Market Animals.
