

Pesticide Classification Definition – License is good for 3 years

Lookup when their license expires – go to <https://kellysolutions.com/NE/>

- Select “Certified Pesticide Applicators Search”
- Search by Applicator Last Name
- Enter in Last Name and Select Applicator Type (Commercial, Non-commercial or Private)

If their name is not present then they are likely expired and need to attend training.

Private Applicator – Will be using *Restricted Use Pesticide (RUP)* for the purpose of production any agriculture commodity on property owned or rented by him/her/their or his/her/their employee. Fee for face-to-face training is **\$60** – No test required. They have the option to complete on-line for the same fee of \$60 – need to visit pested.unl.edu or call 402.472.1632.

There is an additional \$25 fee that they must pay to the Nebraska Department of Agriculture prior to getting their card. Questions call Department of Agriculture at 402.471.6852 and speak to Holly Hillebran

Noncommercial Applicator – Will be using any *Restricted Use Pesticide (RUP)* only for lands owned or controlled by his/her/their employer or for a government agency or political subdivision of the state. Examples – Department of Roads employees, city personnel managing mosquitos. Getting license for 1st time requires passing a test give by the Department of Agriculture.

Must register for class on-line at: <https://pested.unl.edu/> cost is \$95

No additional charge to receive their card.

Commercial Applicator – Will be using *Restricted Use Pesticide (RUP)* on a contractual for “for hire” basis. Getting license for 1st time requires passing a test given by the Department of Agriculture.

Must register for class on-line at: <https://pested.unl.edu/> cost is \$95

There is an additional \$90 fee that they must pay to the Nebraska Department of Agriculture prior to getting their card. Questions call Department of Agriculture at 402.471.6852 and speak to Holly Hillebran

Commercial/Non-commercial Applicators receive certification in specific categories.

- 00 – General Standards (everyone is required to have this category)
- 01 – Agricultural Pest Control – Plant
 - 01A– Fumigation of soil
- 02 – Agricultural Pest Control – Animal
- 03 – Forest Pest Control
- 04 – Ornamental and Turf Pest Control
- 05 – Aquatic Pest control
- 05S – Sewer Root Control
- 06 – Seed Treatment
- 07 – Right-of-Way Pest Control
- 08 – Structural/Health Related Pest Control
 - 08W – Wood Destroying Organisms
- 09 – Public Health Pest Control
- 10 – Wood Preservation
- 11 – Fumigation (Non-soil and Structural Fumigation)
- 12 – Aerial Pest Control
- 14 – Wildlife Damage Control

Chemigation – License is good for 4 years. Required by anybody who will pump chemical, fertilizer or pesticide through the a pivot. No fee but required to pass a 50 questions test.

Their letter did ask for them to pre-register because some of the locations have limited space. Amy doesn't require it for any of her trainings.

Nitrogen Certification Training – License is good for 4 years. Training provided by the NRD. Anyone applying nitrogen fertilizer on an area larger than one acre and using more than 50 pounds per acre of actual nitrogen on any crop must be trained.
