2024 Food Stand Requirements and Shifts

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY:

- The State Health Department requires each person working in the food stand to wear some type of head covering. You will need to bring a CLEAN cap, visor, or bandana for your use.
- For safety reasons, no children under the age of 8 are permitted in the food stand.
- Each of the following requirements MUST be met or it will result in a loss of incentive money:
 - 1. Each 4-Her must work their ENTIRE shift in the food stand.
 - 2. Each 4-H family must have an ADULT (18 or older) working with their family members.
 - 3. Each 4-H family is asked to donate \$15 to purchase a pie.
- If you must change times or days, it is YOUR responsibility to find someone to take your place. <u>Call Ashley at 308-536-2691 if you have switched times with another family.</u> Please try to trade shifts with a similar sized family. <u>If you switch during the fair, please notify Christie Warner at 308-550-0190, as she is the food stand manager this year.</u> It will then be marked on the master schedule in the food stand.
- Please try to drop your \$15 donation off to Ashley at the Extension
 Office or <u>personally give to Christie Warner</u> at the food stand at your shift.

Thank you all for your understanding of these requirements. The profits from the food stand help fund the 4-H program each year. Good luck with all your projects & we look forward to a great county fair!
