

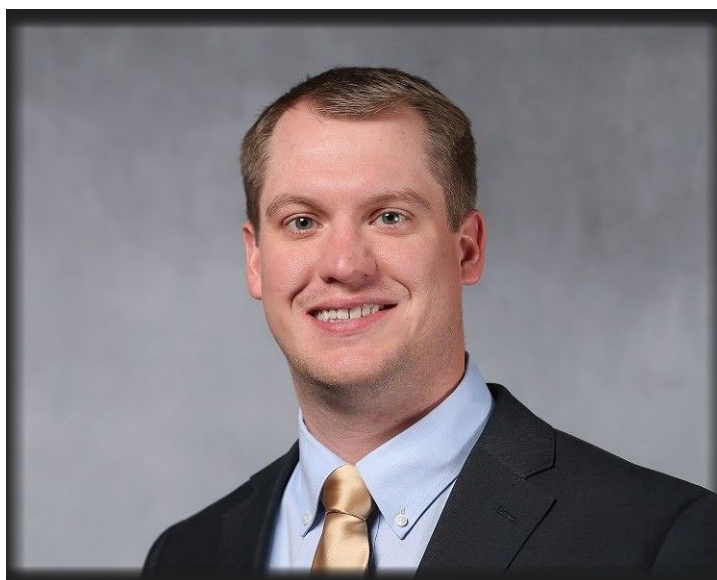

The areas I work in include: rangelands, mixed pasture establishment/grazing, hay land, ruminant nutrition, crop, cover crop, and corn stalk grazing & baling – to name just a few.
