Time to enroll in 2023-24 4-H year All youth and volunteers need to register

The 4-H enrollment site is now open for returning 4-H members, volunteers and to newcomers who have not yet joined. Shooting sports members must be enrolled in 4-H to practice and participate. Please visit https://v2.4honline.com/#/user/sign-in to enroll. **To complete the enrollment process, you must select the 'pay by check' option regardless of your chosen payment method and you must select 'submit' at the end of the process.** If you choose to pay by cash or check, just drop your payment off at the Extension office or mail to 1400 E. 34th St. Kearney, NE 68847. The Buffalo County 4-H Council is an essential group of adults and youth volunteers who meet, on the fourth Tuesday of most months in the evening, to evaluate and plan 4-H programs, events and fundraisers, set policies, and decide upon other 4-H management issues.

Individuals who are interested in making 4-H a growing and thriving program may consider the following two-year positions:

Secretary:

Keep the minutes of all regular and special council meetings and managing correspondences.

Shooting Sports Representative:

Duties shall include directing committees involving youth programs in the field of shooting sports and serving on the P.A.T. during their term in office.

Agriculture Representative:

Duties shall include directing committees involving youth programs in the field of agriculture and serving on at least one livestock P.A.T. during their term in office.

Family & Consumer Sciences Representative:

Duties shall include directing committees involving youth programs in the field of Family & Consumer Sciences and Science, Engineering and Technology. This person shall serve a two-year term on the FCS/SET P.A.T. during their time in office.

Youth Representatives:

Duties shall include representing youth interests on the 4-H Council. Youth representatives must be at least 12 years old, as of January 1st of the current year, to be considered. There shall be four (4) youth representatives, selected each year for a one-year term. They will be elected by ballot using the same rules as for the adult 4-H Council members. The four youth receiving the most votes will be the youth representatives.

BB Gun, Air Rifle & Air Pistol Programs to begin Buffalo County Shooting Sports 4-H Club set for season

Volunteers Needed:

Help is always needed and appreciated. No training is required to assist instructors.

BB Gun

Youth must be 8 to 15 years old to participate in BB Gun. Members need to complete all four positions in BB Gun to advance from Novice to Intermediate. A parent or other responsible adult must be with members at every meeting. Choose the night that works best for you to shoot BB Gun throughout the season.

Important Program Dates

Programs commence on Monday, November 13 and Tuesday, November 14 from 6:30-8:00 p.m. at the Buffalo County Extension Building.

Mondays: Novice BB Gun, Air Rifle & Air Pistol

Tuesdays: BB Gun - split between Novice & Intermediates

Note: Enter via the north door



Air Rifle

It is preferred that members participating in air rifle have completed at least one year of BB Gun, have shot all positions and are 12 years of age or older. Coaches may consider younger than 12 if a youth demonstrates physical capability to handle firearm properly and safely.

Air Pistol

It has yet to be determined on whether this discipline will be offered this year. Eligible youth must be at least 12 years old and can demonstrate to coaches they are physically capable of pumping and holding the pistol unsupported for 40 shots two-handed (ages 12-14) and one-handed (ages 15-18).

Other things to note about the program

- There is no cost to participants for the winter shooting sports program. The only item shooters need to supply is their own eye protection. If a member wears prescription eyeglasses, they do not need separate eye protection. For scratch-free storage, place protective glasses in a sock or cloth bag.
- Long-sleeved shirts and natural fiber pants are recommended nylon/synthetic fabrics tend to be too
 slick to hold shooting positions properly. NO high-top sneakers, boots or anything that extends beyond
 ankle bone are allowed.


