### HALTER CLASSES

**Pony Halter**—either sex, 14.2 hands or under  
**Yearling Fillies**—one division, **2 & 3 Year Old Fillies**—one division  
**Yearling Geldings**—one division, **2 & 3 Year Old Geldings**—one division  
**Aged Mares**—one division  
**Aged Geldings**—one division

### SHOWMANSHIP

**Senior**—Age 15-18 years old as of Jan. 1, 2022  
**Intermediate**—Age 12-14 years old as of Jan. 1, 2022  
**Junior**—Age 8-11 years old as of Jan. 1, 2022

### PERFORMANCE CLASSES

**2 & 3 Year Old Snaffle Bit** (horse may NOT be used in any other pleasure class)  
**Western Pleasure**—three divisions (horse may not cross enter Ranch Pleasure)  
**Ranch Pleasure**—three divisions (horse may not cross enter Western Pleasure)

### PERFORMANCE CLASSES cont.

**Walk-Trot Pleasure** (participant may NOT ride in any other pleasure class)  
**Pony Pleasure 14.2 hands & under** (one division, horse may NOT be used in any other pleasure class)  
**Western Horsemanship**—three divisions  
**Walk-Trot Horsemanship** (participant may NOT ride in any other horsemanship class)  
**Trail**—three divisions  
**Walk-Trot Trail** (participant may NOT ride in any other Trail class)  
**Ranch Riding**—three divisions  
**Western Riding**—one divisions  
**Senior Reining** (passed level 2 & no walk-trot exhibitors allowed)  
**Intermediate Reining** (passed level 2 & no walk-trot exhibitors allowed)  
**Junior Reining** (no walk-trot exhibitors allowed)

### TIMED EVENTS

**Poles**—three divisions + walk trot  
**Barrels**—three divisions + walk trot  
**Keyhole**—three divisions + walk trot
