

How to Enter 4-H Static Exhibits at the Buffalo County Fair

All non-animal exhibits are called static exhibits. To exhibit in the 4-H project areas, members MUST be enrolled in the respective project unless they participated in a workshop.

The Buffalo County Fair Premium book, <https://extension.unl.edu/statewide/buffalo/fair-premium-book/>, lists all static exhibit classes and gives detailed information on what each exhibit needs to make it complete.

Each individual is limited to only one entry per class number.

Static Exhibit Check-In

Tuesday, July 19, 4-7 pm EVERYTHING

Wednesday, July 20, 7-8 am FOOD


Wednesday, July 20, 7-9:30 am HORT.

All entry tags, additional information, recipe cards, data tags, etc. MUST be attached at check-in.

Entry Tags

EACH exhibit must have a Static Exhibit Entry Tag attached and exhibitor's name on the item. All entry tags must have complete information. It is highly encouraged to pick up entry tags from the Extension Office and fill them out beforehand, however, entry tags will be available during check-in.

Interview Judging Wednesday, July 20

Interview Judging is an opportunity for 4-H members to talk to judges about their static exhibit and share their trials and lessons they learned. 4-H'ers also learn what the judge looks for and how to improve skills. Interview judging is Wednesday, July 20 from 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. 4-H'ers may interview judge 3 total exhibits. Please call 308-236-1235 starting July 1 to sign up for a time slot. Some slots will fill up fast. If slots are still available, you may sign up during Static Exhibit Check-In on Tuesday, July 19, 4-7 pm. For horticulture, you can sign up at check-in.

Please mark on the Static Exhibit Entry Tag if it is to be interview judged.

Static Exhibits Open to the Public Thursday, July 21 at 1 pm

Static exhibits are judged on Wednesday, July 20 from 8 am until finished – and are NOT open to the public during judging. Static exhibits open to the public and exhibitors on Thursday, July 21 at 1 pm.

State Fair Static Exhibits

For a static exhibit to be considered eligible for state fair, exhibit must receive a purple ribbon and be an eligible state fair class. At the county fair, 4-H static exhibits will be selected for the Nebraska State Fair by the judges in the respective areas. A state fair recognition piece will be placed on all exhibits selected for state fair. Alternates will be chosen and notified if they become eligible to participate.

Note: in many cases, level 1 projects do not advance to the state fair. In the Fair Book, it is indicated if it's a state fair eligible class or not.

4-H members with qualifying exhibits for the state fair will receive a letter with the exhibit explaining the details for exhibiting at the state fair.

Static Exhibit Release Time Sunday, July 24, 4 pm-5:30 pm

All static exhibits will be released on Sunday, July 24 from 4:00 to 5:30 pm. Please pick up your projects during this time. NO EARLY RELEASES!
