

Adams County Progress Show Rules and Regulations 2024

General Show Information (Beef, Sheep, Goats, Rabbit & Poultry):

- Open to all 4-H and FFA members
- Exhibitors must be at least 8 and no more than 18 years old before January 1 of the current year, with the exception of Clover Kid showmanship. Clover Kid Showmanship Ages of 5 7 noncompetitive, animals under 350 pounds.
- The Show Committee will have the final decision on class breaks and registration paper discrepancies.
- Ribbons & Overall Awards will be given. Cas Prizes will also be awarded.
- Stalling: Barns will be open starting at 6:00pm on Friday eve to stall overnight or you may stall in your trailer. Bedding will not be provided. Wood chips may be used for bedding, no straw allowed. Stalling is first come first serve. There will not be a check-in on Friday eve. Remember you MUST clean up after yourselves regardless of whether you stall in the barns or tie out at your trailer. Please leave the facilities as you found them. Your area will need to be cleared to leave by show staff /committee before exiting the show.
- Dress: Show attire 4-H\FFA shirt not required. No halter tops or sleeveless shirts\blouses
- **Health Requirements:** At the progress show committee discretion All livestock are subject to examination, upon arrival, for evidence of infectious or contagious diseases, open wounds, and other animal health concerns. If found, animals will not be allowed onto the grounds. Under no circumstances may animals under quarantine be exhibited.
- Exhibitors will declare weights. Exhibitors must weigh their animals using the scale supplied at the show. Weigh cards must be completed and turned in during designated check in time and location. The weight listed on the weigh card will become that animals official declared weight to be used for assignment to a class.
- Wash racks available.
- All shows are full fit (optional).
- Beef will be shown in the indoor horse arena.
- Sheep & Goats will be shown in the outdoor livestock arena.
- Poultry & Rabbits will be shown in the west end of the Activities Center.
- The Sullivan Supply Trailer will be on site for your show needs.

- Early Bird registration will be available until June 10th.
- The final day to register is June 22^{nd} .
- Exhibitor Fees for each beef, sheep & goat will be:
 - \$20.00 for a pre-registered (early bird registration) Adams County Exhibitor
 - \$25.00 for a pre-registered (early bird registration) Exhibitor
 - \$30.00 for registration on the day of the show
- Exhibitor Fee for each (limited to 10 per species, per exhibitor) poultry exhibit and rabbit exhibit will be \$2.00 for a pre-registered (early bird registration) Adams County Exhibitor \$3.00 for a pre-registered (early bird registration) Exhibitor
 - \$4.00 for registration on the day of the show
- Showmanship Fees will be:
 - \$5.00 for Beef, Sheep and Goats
 - \$2.00 for Poultry and Rabbit
 - Free for Clover Kids
- Scales will be available & check in will be from 7:00am 8:30am
- Show starting at 9:30am

Showmanship Classes: All ages before January 1, of the current year

- Senior Division 14 and older
- Intermediate Division 11-13
- Junior Division 8-10
- Clover Kids 5-7 (non-competitive and animals under 350 pounds).

Sheep & Meat Goat Show Information

Meat Goats\Market Lambs:

- Must be born in 2024
- All market lambs & meat goats must have a scrapies tag.
- All market lambs & meat goats will be shown by weight. No re-weighs.
- Ewes, Does and Wethers will be shown together.
- Goat are to have milk teeth and there shall be no evidence of breaking of the skin or eruption of the two permanent front teeth. Goats must have horns blunted.
- Goats are to be shown with neck chains, halters, or smooth collars only.
- Short scrotum, cryptorchid and buck kids are not eligible.

Beef Show Information

Market Beef:

- All market animals must be born in 2023.
- Market Steers and Heifers will be shown by weight. Steers & Heifers will be shown together.
- All market beef must have a current 4-H, FFA or an EID ear tag in place to be eligible to show.

Breeding Heifers:

- Heifers must be born between January 2023 August 2023
- All breeding heifers must be identified by legible ear tattoo(s).

Rabbit Show Information

- Rabbits will be shown by breed in the following divisions Fancy (Jr/Sr), Commercial (Jr/Int/Sr), Pet
- Best of Breed is awarded to each breed that has 2 or more exhibitors and 3 or more entries.
- Overall awards will be given.
- Special Contests
 - Rabbit Skillathon
 - Best Dressed Contest
- All rabbits must have a permanent, legible tattoo in their left ear.
- All rabbits must be in carriers with leak proof bottoms.

Poultry Show Information

- Poultry classes include
- Standard (female/male), Bantam (female/male), Water Fowl and All Other Fowl.
- Class awards will be given when there are 2 or more exhibitors and 3 or more entries.
- Overall Awards Given
- All poultry must be in carriers with leak proof bottoms.




