## IDENTIFICATION OF 4-H ANIMALS FOR NEBRASKA DISTRICT, STATE AND INTERSTATE SHOWS

Only 4-H members 12 years of age or older on January 1 of the current year will be certified for state or interstate shows. For District Dairy Shows, the minimum age is 10 as of January 1 of the current year.

## Horse

Animals must be identified by color markings or photograph. Project animals not owned by the exhibitor or his family must have an affidavit from the owner certifying that the exhibitor will manage and have access to the horse at least 75 percent of the time during the course of the project year. The term **manage** includes **all** of the following: feeding, grooming, exercising, training, stall management and use of the horse.
