- ♦ What to bring: Hay/feed for horses (Certified Weed Free required at Soldier Creek), shavings for stall, buckets, feed pans, bed rolls, towels, tents, toiletries, campers, all-weather boots, clothing (wet/dry, cold/hot), flashlight, a smile, baling wire, thingamajig, rope, hammer, camera, pitchfork, and a horse you can handle.
