STATE FAIR STATIC EXHIBITORS

Watch your email for instructions and a list of your State Fair eligible exhibits. Please read the reminder carefully to prepare your exhibit for State Fair. If you received a state fair postcard and pin on your project and did not get an email, please contact the office.

If all supporting material or labeling is not done correctly, the exhibit can be dropped a placing or even disqualified.

State Fair Static Exhibits are due to the Extension Office by 5:00 pm on Thursday, August 18.

State Fair Food and Horticulture Exhibits are due to the Extension Office by 5:00 pm on Tuesday, August 23.

STATE FAIR TICKET INFORMATION

Livestock & In-Person Contest Families: All Beef, Swine, Sheep, Goat, Rabbit and Poultry 4-H/FFA exhibitors will automatically receive an 11-day admission wristband at no cost. Exhibitors will not have to select a wristband as it will automatically be provided with the livestock, rabbit and/or poultry entry. *4-H Dog Exhibitors and other non-livestock in-person entries (4-H Contests, Fashion Show, Presentations and the Robotics Showcase) will receive a free daily gate pass.* All purchased items will be in the exhibitor packet when the exhibitor checks in at the Livestock Check-In Trailer. Additional 11-Day Fair Wristbands can be purchased for \$25 and Daily Gate Passes for \$5 on the State Fair website. Livestock Exhibitor Parking Passes in the 3A/3B lot are available on the website for \$25. Deadline is 8:00 pm on August 10 for online livestock and contest entries. No exceptions! Static Exhibitors: The 4-H static exhibitor families will be able to order discount passes directly from the Nebraska State Fair! Orders can be placed using the following link and password. Please remember the opportunity to order these discounted tickets is for **static exhibitors and their families only**. The misuse of this resource may eliminate this opportunity in the future, so please only use this if your 4-H'er is entering static exhibits! 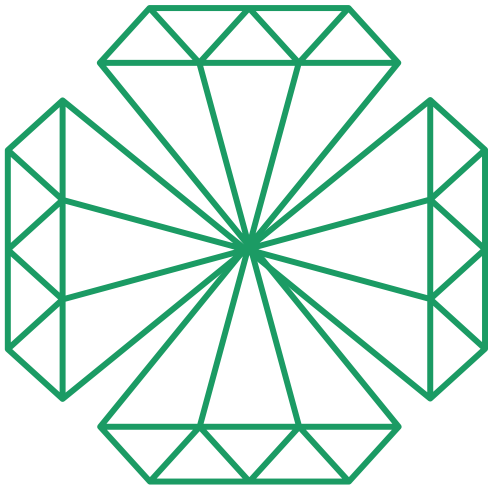

DIAMOND CLOVER AWARD INFORMATION

The Diamond Clover Award Program encourages youth to engage in a variety of programs, projects and activities that will enable youth to acquire skills and abilities that will prepare them for success in the future. Nebraska 4-H Annual Achievement Application for Awards and Recognition

The Nebraska 4-H Achievement Application is a standard application form used for the selection of county and state award winners, including Nebraska delegates to National 4-H Congress and National 4-H Conference, as well as Nebraska 4-H Foundation scholarship award recipients. *To serve as a delegate for National 4-H Congress or Conference, youth must turn ages 15-19 during the calendar year in which the trip occurs. If you are interested in being considered as a delegate for these national experiences, you will make the designation on your application.*

APPLICANTS

- All youth, aged 8-18, are encouraged to complete this application for acknowledgement of your annual achievements in 4-H and to be eligible for county and state level awards.

COMPLETING THE APPLICATION

- The application is designed to be completed electronically. Limit responses in the "My Experiences" section to a maximum of three pages, single-spaced, 12 point font. *A fourth page is allowed for those applying for the National trips.*
- In the selection process, significant accomplishments in your 4-H experience, leadership, community involvement and career spark (potential career choice) are given more consideration than number of projects completed.
- Please do not send a list of your awards. You may include selected awards as part of the "My Experiences" section of the application.
- Creativity is encouraged; use bullet lists, photos, infographics, etc. to help tell your 4-H story.

APPLICATION SUBMISSION

- Submit the following elements via email (butler-county@unl.edu) to Butler County Extension by **October 3**. Applications can also be submitted via mail or drop-off.
- The completed application will include:
 - An "About Me" page
 - The "My Experience" answers (3 page maximum)
 - Additional responses required for *national experience applicants only* (1 page maximum)

NATIONAL EXPERIENCE APPLICANTS

- **National 4-H Conference** is held in March in Chevy Chase, Maryland. This is the premier national civic engagement opportunity for 4-H members across the country. Delegates not only learn while at the conference but also have the opportunity to practice and apply in a real-world setting their newly developed and refined skills. - **National 4-H Congress** is held in late November in Atlanta, Georgia. This program is an educational experience designed to make an impact. Youth will expand their skills, engage with other 4-H members and be inspired to make an impact in their club, community, country and world. TO BE A DELEGATE

- Applicants must:
 - Turn age 15-19 during the calendar year in which the trip occurs to be considered.
 - Not have been a delegate to the program in which they are applying.
 - Be able to miss one full week of school and/or work to attend the program.
 - Be a participant in the Nebraska 4-H Program in any delivery mode.
 - Be dependable and punctual.
- If selected, delegates will:
 - Participate in an orientation and complete pre-program assignments.
 - Check and respond to email and other online information regularly in preparation for the leadership experience.
 - Participate fully in the program.
 - Carry out follow-up responsibilities designated by the 4-H program.
 - Make public appearances for 4-H.
 - **Expenses:** The Nebraska 4-H Foundation provides partial scholarships. Delegates will be responsible for travel to and from the airport from home, meals to and from the leadership experience location, optional tours and souvenirs they wish to purchase.

COMPLETING YOUR APPLICATION

- One additional page is allowed for delegate applicants.
- As you complete your application, remember that while participation in 4-H programs, leadership and community are important, the information you share when you return from the leadership experience is equally important.
- You are encouraged to submit the application electronically. A selection team will screen applications. Applicants may be contacted for additional information.
- Chosen delegates may be required to travel to an airport that is not the closest to them due to chaperone location and cost restrictions.
- Following the county review, make revisions if needed and submit the applications for state review by January 15.
 - If you did not previously submit an application to Butler County, you are still eligible to submit by January 15 for all considerations of the state level award and scholarships.
 - **All applications for state awards and delegate selection should be submitted via email to: 4HAchieves@unl.edu.** Files should be labeled with the applicants last name, first name and county. For example, *MeuschAlieshaButler*.
