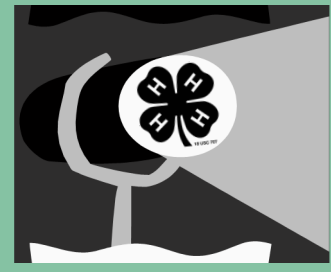

Market Animals	Due Date	County Fair Only	State Fair (DNA Envelope)
Beef	June 15	4-H Tag & ID Sheet	EID Tag and DNA & online nomination
Swine	June 15	Ear Notch, ID Sheet & Premise ID	EID Tag and DNA & online nomination
Sheep	June 15	Scrapie Tag and ID Sheet	Scrapie Tag and DNA & online nomination
Goat	June 15	Scrapie Tag and ID Sheet	Scrapie Tag and DNA & online nomination

All livestock with an EID tag must have a Premise ID on record at the Extension Office.

State Fair: Animal information must be nominated, paid for and submitted via www.showstockmgr.com by the exhibitor family on or before the due date listed. NE State Fair entries can be made at www.statefair.org. Due date, Aug. 10th.

Diamond Clover Awards Program



All 4-H'ers are invited to fill out an application for the Diamond Clover Awards program. It is an achievable goal-setting and application process.

There are six levels. Youth can start at the beginning or at the age level associated with the award. For each level, there is a list of possible accomplishments from which 4-H youth choose their goals. The accomplishments increase in quantity and difficulty for each level. At the beginning of the 4-H year, participants plan what to accomplish and at the end of the 4-H year, they report on their completed accomplishments. Goal sheets are due April 15 and reports are due October 15. Successful completion of a level's Plan & Report form results in a 4-H youth earning that level of the Diamond Clover program.
