Butler County 4-H Fair Updates and Reminders

Static Project Department:

- Static project entry cards will be available for pick-up at the Extension Office prior to fair entry days. Please pick them up and have them attached to your project! Any cards left will be brought to entry days.
- Interview Judging Youth will only be allowed to interview judge for TWO items in each
 project area. For example if a youth has four projects under Home Design and Restoration,
 they can only interview judge two.
- Interview Judging All youth planning to interview judge will need to report to their final
 interview no later than 11:30 am. If you arrive and hope to interview judge at 11:45 am you
 will not be able to sign-up for interview judging. This decision was made to help the flow of
 judging.
- Modeling There will be no judging of modeling on Wednesday during entry days. This will be judged during the Fashion Show on Tuesday, July 2 at 2 pm.

- Premium Payout and Release
 - Static project release and premium payout begins at 6:00 pm.
 - Exhibitors will receive a premium check instead of cash.

Clover Kid Project Department:

- The new Clover Kid project limit is 12 the limit was previously 10.
 - Please work to adhere to this limit due to availability of space in the Exhibit Hall.
- Project Drop Off:
 - Clover Kid projects will use the East door of the Butler County Event Center for project entry on Tuesday, July 11 and Wednesday, July 12.

Livestock Project Department:

- Beef, Goat, Sheep + Swine:
 - Minimum weights are clearly listed in the fairbook for each specie to align with the Nebraska State Fair 4-H Fairbook.
 - If an animal does not meet the minimum weight, they will be put in a production class. In this class, animals are eligible to receive a purple but NOT eligible for champion selection.
- Stall Cards, Markers, etc.
 - These items will be available in the Northeast corner stall of the Beef Barn. This is a more convenient and an easily accessible location.
 - Show orders will be posted here as well as in their respective barns.

Livestock Project Department:


- Herdsmanship
 - A new point opportunity to go into the total herdsmanship score has been added.
 - Participation in the county fair exhibit hall set-up and/or fairgrounds clean-up days. The number of club members who attend will be taken into a percentage compared to the total number of members in the club.
 - The maximum amount of points is 100 per day, per specie with a total accumulative points at the fair being 2000 points. 100 maximum points from set-up/clean-up will be added to the 2000 cumulative points.
- Premium Payout and Release
 - Livestock animal release begins at 6:00 pm this year.
 - Exhibitors will still receive cash in the ring.

Awards Program.

- Static
 - Champions and Reserve Champions will receive a trophy.
 - Champion pictures will be **Saturday, July 13 at 1:00 pm** during the Award Show.
- Livestock
 - o Champions and Reserve Champions will receive a banner.
 - Showmanship winners will receive a rosette and buckle buckle ceremony will be at the Awards Banquet. Date TBA.
 - Horse awards will remain the same as 2023. A high-point boy and girl buckle will be awarded.
- Round Robin
 - Champion and Reserve Champion will receive a quarter-zip wind breaker jacket ordered after the fair.

4-H Staff at the fair:

- Office:
 - 4-H Staff has the use of the Event Center Office.
 - We are not there very often but will post a sign on the door when we are in office!
 - Otherwise we will be out and about on the fairgrounds.
- Suggestion Box:
 - There will be a box by the ticket window in the Event Center AND in the Northeast corner stall of the Beef Barn.
 - The purpose is to bring suggestions regarding the fair to the Butler County 4-H Council
 and Butler County 4-H Staff for discussion to bring potential changes.

Bucket Calf Program

NEW: Bucket calf record books MUST be turned into the Extension Office by **Monday, July 8.** This is to make sure the judge can view them prior to the show for the interview portion.

Butler County fair Swine Show

NEW: All swine shown at the Butler County Fair, both market and breeding, must be born on or after <u>December 1, 2023.</u>

Butler County fair goat Show

NEW: Moving forward during the 4-H Goat Show at the Butler County Fair, the wethers and does will show together. An overall market goat will be selected. This decision was not made lightly but is due to the low number of goats in the show. If numbers go up, this decision will be revisited.

Livestock Achievement Program


All livestock with an EID tag must have a Premise ID on record at the Extension Office.

Entry deadline for the Nebraska State Fair is August 10 at 8:00 pm.
