

Butler County 4-H Fair Updates and Reminders

Static Project Department:

- Static project entry cards will be available for pick-up at the Extension Office prior to fair entry days. Please pick them up and have them attached to your project! Any cards left will be brought to entry days.
- Modeling There will be no judging of modeling on Wednesday during entry days. This will be judged during the Fashion Show on Thursday, July 6 at 2 pm.
- Data cards and supplemental information can be found on our website or picked up at our office. Find them online here: https://extension.unl.edu/statewide/butler/butler-county-fairbook-4-h-entry-forms/.
- Premium Payout and Release
 - Static project release and premium payout begins at 6:00 pm this year.
 - Exhibitors will receive a premium check instead of cash.

Clover Kid Project Department:

- The new Clover Kid project limit is 12 the limit was previously 10.
 - Please work to adhere to this limit due to availability of space in the Exhibit Hall.
- Project Drop Off:
 - Clover Kid projects will use the East door of the Butler County Event Center for project entry on Tuesday, July 11 and Wednesday, July 12.

Livestock Project Department:

- Beef, Goat, Sheep + Swine:
 - Minimum weights are clearly listed in the fairbook for each specie to align with the Nebraska State Fair 4-H Fairbook.
 - If an animal does not meet the minimum weight, they will be put in a production class. In this class, animals are eligible to receive a purple but NOT eligible for champion selection.
- Hein Building
 - Stall cards, markers, etc. will NOT be located in the Hein Building this year and moving forward.
 - These items will be available in the Northeast corner stall of the Beef Barn. This is a more convenient and an easily accessible location.
 - Show orders will be posted here as well as in their respective barns.

Butler County 4-H Fair Updates and Reminders

Livestock Project Department:

- Herdsmanship
 - A new point opportunity to go into the total herdsmanship score has been added.
 - Participation in the county fair exhibit hall set-up and/or fairgrounds clean-up days. The number of club members who attend will be taken into a percentage compared to the total number of members in the club.
 - The maximum amount of points is 100 making the total for herdsmanship 200 points.
- Premium Payout and Release
 - Livestock animal release begins at 6:00 pm this year.
 - Exhibitors will still receive cash in the ring.

Awards Program.

- Static
 - Champions and Reserve Champions will receive a trophy.
 - Champion pictures will be Saturday, July 15 at 1:00 pm during the Award Show.
- Livestock
 - o Champions and Reserve Champions will receive a banner.
 - Showmanship winners will receive a rosette and buckle buckle ceremony will be on November 8 at the Awards Banquet.
 - Horse awards will remain the same as 2022. A high-point boy and girl buckle will be awarded.
- Round Robin
 - Champion and Reserve Champion will receive a quarter-zip wind breaker jacket **ordered after the fair**.

4-H Staff at the fair:

- · Office:
 - 4-H Staff has the use of the Event Center Office.
 - We are not there very often but will post a sign on the door when we are in office!
 - Otherwise we will be out and about on the fairgrounds.
- Suggestion Box:
 - There will be a box by the ticket window in the Event Center AND in the Northeast corner stall of the Beef Barn.
 - The purpose is to bring suggestions regarding the fair to the Butler County 4-H Council and Butler County 4-H Staff for discussion to bring potential changes.

Butler County 4-H Livestock Program Related Updates and Information

State Fair Livestock Nominations

State Fair Nominations will be online again this year and nominations are now open via www.showstockmgr.com. State Fair tags and DNA envelopes are available at the Extension Office. The deadline for ALL online nominations and DNA envelopes returned to the Extension Office is June 15.

House 4-H Program

NEW: The speed/game events at the Butler County Fair 4-H Horse Show will be split into three divisions instead of two. Divisions are: Junior (8-11), Intermediate (12-14) and Senior (15-18).

Beef and Swine Ear Tags

NEW: Beginning this year, beef and swine **county** ear tags will cost \$1/tag to purchase. This change is due to the swine identification process changing. EID tags for State Fair for both beef and swine are \$2.50/tag to purchase.

Swine Identification and Weigh-In Process

NEW: Swine will now be required to have tags in their ear by the **June 15 ID Sheet Deadline.** This is to streamline the weigh-in process during the Butler County Fair Weigh-In.
As stated above, tags will be \$1/tag for county tags. **Ear notches will NOT be accepted as a form of identification for swine moving forward.**

Bucket Calf Program

NEW: Bucket calf record books MUST be turned into the Extension Office by **Monday, July 10.** This is to make sure the judge can view them prior to the show for the interview portion.

Livestock Award Program

NEW: Champion and Reserve Champions will receive a banner. Showmanship winners will receive a rosette and a buckle. The buckle ceremony will be after the fair on **November 8** at the **Butler County 4-H Awards and Recognition Banquet.** This is due to the cost of the buckles and the uncertainty of having a champion and reserve champion showman in each division. Horse Show awards will remain the same as 2022. There will be a high-point buckle awarded for both boy and girl in the Horse Show. Round Robin Champion and Reserve Champion will receive a quarter-zip wind breaker jacket that will be ordered after the fair.


