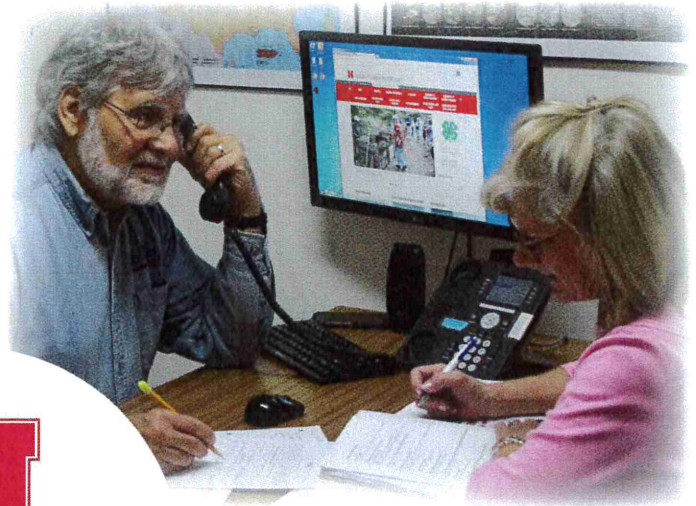


Do you have a strong interest in gardening? Do you enjoy helping others?
