Rules & Show Order for 2018

*This show is a Junior Nebraska Cattlemen sanctioned show. Junior Nebraska Cattlemen rules and guidelines will be used and can be found at www.showcattlepage.com.

*This show is open to all 2018 Nebraska, Iowa, Kansas, and Missouri youth, meeting age and affiliation guidelines, of the Junior Nebraska Cattlemen.



BREEDING HEIFERS: must be born between September 1, 2016 & December 31, 2017.

- * Registered heifers must be accompanied by the original copy of their registration paper in order to show in their respective breed class.
- * Breed classes will be provided for all breeds as required by JNC guidelines.
- * A commercial breeding heifer class will be provided for animals without current registration papers.
- * Progress Show management reserves the right to combine age classes within breeds to make certain there is competition for cattle entered, where the number of entries do not warrant all age classes.



MARKET HEIFERS:

- * All market heifers will be shown together in classes from lightweight to heavyweight.
- * There will be NO breed classes in the market heifer show.



MARKET STEERS:

- * Classes will be provided to meet JNC guidelines for breeds. Original copy of registration paper are required for animal to be shown in specific breed class.
- * A crossbred division will be provided.
- * If breed classes need to be divided by weight, they will be shon lightweight to heavyweight.

- * Fairgrounds will open Saturday @ 6:00 pm
- * We ask that exhibitors park trailers on the south or west sides of the Alice Arena.
- * No bedding is provided Wood chips/shavings are permitted to be brought in by exhibitor
- * At the end of the show exhibitors are asked to pull all bedding away from panels and walls of stalls. If stalling next to trailers, please clean all bedding and manure from area and place in roll off containers provided on the grounds.
- * Generators are encouraged as there is limited electrical space. Progress show management expects exhibitors to operate generators in a safe and courteous manner.
