

WELDING WORKSHOP

LOCATION: Northeast Community College — Norfolk

RECOMMENDED: Youth must be 12 years of age to participate. Youth who are enrolled in 4-H Welding. An adult to accompany you.

DESCRIPTION: John Knapp, Northeast Community College Instructor, will be teaching youth the welding process using the GMAW/MIG Welding process. Youth will complete the welding joints exhibit for the fair; displaying one butt, one lap, and one fillet weld.
