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### Grant Application for a 4-H Club/Group Project

The Cedar County 4-H Foundation has available up to \$200 grants for clubs or groups of 4-H members to plan and conduct a community service project, citizenship project, or club educational experience. An application for approval of the project must be submitted to the 4-H Council. Applications will be reviewed at the next scheduled council meeting. Moneys will be granted upon approval of the project.

Clubs/Groups are then required to promote/share their project using at least 2-3 media sources (Twitter, Facebook, radio, local newspapers, flyers, local channels, etc). Upon completion of the activity, a summary of the project with pictures and proof of media reach must be submitted to the 4-H Council by September 15.
