The 4-H Council will be awarding scholarships to graduating 4-H members who will be attending at least one year of trade school, college or university in the fall of 2023. Four Council scholarships will be valued at \$25 for each year of the member's Cedar County 4-H membership with a maximum of \$250.00.

Enclosed you will find a cover sheet for the scholarship, a list of the rules and a sheet with the application questions. Please note that the application should be no longer than two pages. Place the cover page with the application (this should be the only place your name appears) and send it to the Cedar County Extension Office, PO Box 368, Hartington, NE 68739. The cover page will be removed before judging by the committee. **Applications are due to the Extension Office by April 1, 2023.**

This scholarship is only available to seniors who are enrolled in 4-H and dues paid for the current year or for seniors who were enrolled last year, but no longer meet the 4-H age requirement.

Please answer the following questions on a separate sheet of paper. Application should be no longer than two pages and should be typewritten and double-spaced.

1. How many years have you been in Cedar County 4-H and what is your involvement with 4-H?
2. How has 4-H influenced your life?
3. What was your most important accomplishment in 4-H? Explain.
4. Do you see yourself being involved in the 4-H program in the future? If so, in what capacity.
5. What are your future educational and career goals?



Scholarship Rules

1. To apply, applicant must be a 2022-23 high school senior.
2. Applicant must attend a trade school, college or university in the fall of 2023, and attend two semesters.
3. Applicant must be a 4-H member for the current year with enrollment and dues complete, or a 4-H member who was enrolled last year, but no longer meets the 4-H age requirement.
4. Scholarship will not be awarded until the second semester.
5. Four scholarships shall be awarded to Cedar County 4-H'ers.
6. A pre-determined committee, not members of the 4-H Council, will select the winners and the alternates.
