Your child is invited to participate in Progressive Agriculture Safety Day® at the fairgrounds in Ord, Nebraska on June 4, 2024. Recognized as the largest safety and health education program for children in North America, the purpose of the PAF Safety Day is to teach children ways to stay safe and healthy on farms, ranches, and in rural communities through participation in a variety of age-appropriate, hands-on experiences. Children in grades K-6 (on 1/1/24) are invited. We cannot accept registrations for children who have not attended Kindergarten. Kindergarten through second graders should arrive at 8:30 a.m. Their camp will end at 12:00 noon. Third through sixth graders should arrive at 11:45 a.m. and will be finished at 3:00 p.m. An adult will need to come to the Valley County Ag Complex arena to pick up your child at the time their camp concludes. We will give your child a life jacket and goody bag as you leave together.
