STEAM Clothing 2: Entry must be a complete wearable outfit. A purchased top may be worn with two constructed pieces. Nightshirts, flannel lounging pants or any other type of lounge wear cannot be modeled.

C410031 - Model dress, romper or jumpsuit

C410032 - Model two piece skirt outfit

C410033 – Model two piece pants or shorts outfit

***C410034 - Model upcycled garment**

STEAM Clothing 3: Nightwear or lounge wear cannot be modeled. A purchased top may be included with two constructed pieces.

C410041 – Model dress or formal

C410042 – Model skirt outfit or jumper with shirt

C410043 – Model pants or shorts with top, vest or jacket

C410044 – Model romper or jumpsuit

C410045 – Model specialty wear (swim wear, costumes, western wear or hunting gear)

C410046 – Model non-tailored jacket (additional pieces may be constructed or purchased)

C410047 – Model tailored blazer, suit jacket or coat

***C410048 – Model upcycled garment**

Knitting and Crocheting

C410050 – Model Level 2 or 3 Knitted or Crocheted Outfit (dress or complete outfit)

***C410051 – Model Level 1 Knitted or Crocheted Garment**

Shopping in Style: Age 10 and older. Written report is due when registering for clothing judging day and will be judged prior to clothing judging day. Written report is worth 50% of the total score and is judged on completeness, accurate information and neatness. While modeling, the 4-H'er will be judged for modeling skill, fit and appearance of the outfit, and accessories. This is worth the other 50% of the score.

C410060 – Model Purchased Outfit and written report (SF184). A construction entry in classes C240001-C240006 is required in order to model in this class.

***C410061 –Model \$20 Shopping Challenge Outfit** a **complete, wearable outfit** purchased for no more than \$20 (feel free to use accessories and shoes you already own), for a specific occasion, purpose or activity. Entry includes a written report which requires receipts. 4-H members enrolled in any clothing or consumer management project are eligible. Modeling is a requirement.
