Paper ID sheets **are required** by June 15 for beef, goats, sheep and swine to be exhibited at county fair and any animal you want verified in [showstockmanager.com](http://showstockmanager.com)

Clothing project 4-H'ers should have received an email with clothing day information. If you did not, contact the office immediately or scroll down to find it at <https://extension.unl.edu/statewide/central4/4hforms/>

Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) training is required annually for all 4-H or FFA members exhibiting beef, goats, sheep, swine, poultry or rabbits at any Nebraska county fair. 4-H or FFA members who do not submit a 2024 YQCA completion certificate to the Nebraska Extension Office by June 15 will not be eligible to exhibit livestock.

If you need DNA envelopes for State Fair livestock (breeding heifer, feeder calf, breeding/market goat/sheep/swine), pick them up at the extension office now. If EID tags are required for state fair animals, you can get those also. We are less than two weeks away from the deadline!

**LIVESTOCK DNA:** All livestock in contention to exhibit at the 2024 Nebraska State Fair will be required to submit a DNA nomination (breeding, market and feeder calves). Animals can be nominated for both breeding and market. DNA nominations are \$7.00 per animal and due **June 15**. The website is <https://showstockmgr.com/>. 4-H'ers age 8 and older are eligible.

**AKSARBEN:** 4-H/FFA families who want animals to be nominated for both NE State Fair and Aksarben will only need to submit **ONE** DNA envelope but will now have to nominate animals on two different online nomination sites. More information at <https://aksarbenstockshow.com>
