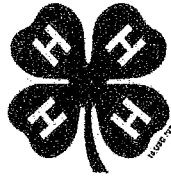
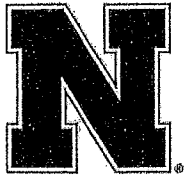
Achievement Applications are Due

EXTENSION

The annual Cheyenne County 4-H Carnival is the primary fundraiser for the 4-H Council. Combined with your annual \$10 membership fee, carnival proceeds pay the operating costs of the 4-H program in Cheyenne County. Funds are used to pay for insurance that covers every 4-H youth, project manuals, postage, camp scholarships, senior scholarships, shooting sports instructor trainings, livestock barn expenses at fair and other expenses. We depend on each member to support the 4-H Council and promote the carnival, by selling raffle tickets and by assisting their club with donations and booths.

CLUB & MEMBER ASSIGNMENTS

Each 4-H member is asked to sell at least 10 raffle tickets. If you need more tickets, please stop by the Extension Office, 920 Jackson Street.

Raffle tickets are \$5 per ticket or 5 tickets for \$20. We have had two large items donated this year and they will each be raffled off separately. Please return your sold and unsold tickets and the money collected in an envelope with your name on it and the number of tickets you sold to either your 4-H leader or bring them to the Extension Office by November 8th or to the carnival. Checks can be made to the Cheyenne County 4-H Council.

CARNIVAL BOOTHS

- Please specify the size of space you need for your booth (1 or 2 spaces)
- No shaving cream may be used in any booth.
- No tape may be applied to the floor.
- Adult supervision is needed in each booth during the carnival.
- Booths will be judged, and prizes awarded. 1st prize - \$100, 2nd prize - \$75, 3rd prize - \$50

- The building will open on Friday from 4:00 -7:00 pm for booth set up.
- Clubs need to provide prizes for participants.
- Each club is responsible for cleaning up all streamers and loose trash from their booth at the end of carnival. If you use any sticky materials such as marshmallows, tape, etc. your club is responsible for making sure ALL of it is cleaned up. No remnants can be left. Trash from the carnival booths must fit inside the dumpsters or be prepared to take it with. All large cardboard must be hauled off.
