Registration Fee

A paid registration fee is due by March 9 to hold a spot at the workshop.

- Early - Adult Registration (by Mar. 9) Fee - **\$110/person** except Apprentice
- Early Apprentice Registration (by Mar. 9) — **\$90/person**
- Late - registration Fee - **\$160/person**

Fee includes program materials and three meals, lunch on Saturday and Sunday, and dinner on Saturday. It does not include lodging.
