Nebraska 4-H Shooting Sports Leader Certification Workshop Offered in Bridgeport

A Nebraska 4-H Shooting Sports Leader Certification Workshop is scheduled for October in Bridgeport, NE. It will be held

October 29-30 at the Prairie Winds Community Center in Bridgeport. The deadline to register for the session is October 19th.

Volunteers have the opportunity to become certified as an adult (21 years and older) or

apprentice (14-20 years old) leader. Five project areas will be offered at the Bridgeport Workshop - rifle, shotgun, hunting skills, pistol, and archery. There is a minimum number of participants needed to offer these disciplines at the workshops. Workshop participants will learn under expert instruction from members of the Nebraska State 4-H Shooting Sports Training Team.

The registration fee is \$100.00 per person for initial certification and \$90.00 per person that are currently a certified instructor and are adding an additional discipline. This fee includes meals, supplies and program materials. Participants must make their own lodging arrangements.

Registration on Saturday runs from 8:00 a.m. to 8:45 a.m.

Photo Tips from Focus on Photography

Project Manual page 19: Many different types of light can be used to take photos. "Natural light" refers to light from the sun. It can be found outdoors and indoors. "Artificial light" refers to all other light sources, including lamps and camera flashes.

Lighting can make the difference between a good photo and a better one. The more you take pictures under different lighting conditions, the more you'll learn about light.
