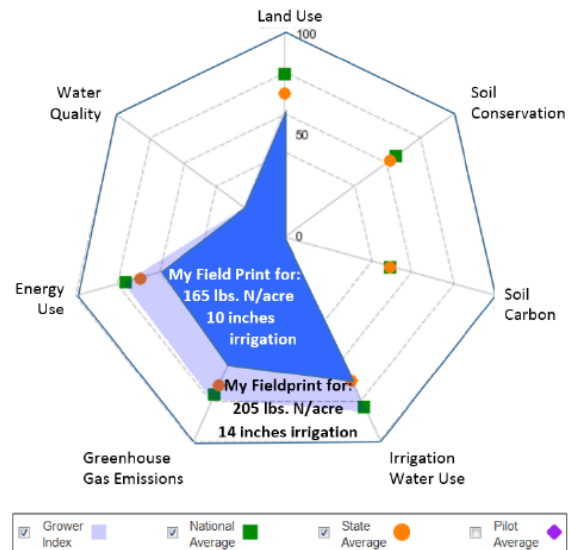


Field to Market Field Assessment to Improve Efficiency

This workshop will use the Field to Market tool which uses farming practices and other production data to produce graphs and tables which allows for a comparison of one field to national, state, and local averages for the metrics of Yield, Irrigation efficiency, erosion, energy use, and green house gas emissions.

- Quantify several environmental indicators *that also effect profit* of a field
- Compare production efficiency with your peers (all data remaining confidential)
- Visualize the production process in a new way helping to expose areas of efficiency and inefficiency
- Identify opportunities to improve efficiency and sustainability
