

4-H Livestock Requirements – 2020

4-H Livestock ID/Ownership requirements for showing at State Fair and AKSARBEN Stock Show. All youth must complete YQCA by June 15. Please review the following guidelines carefully.

- April 15 – All market beef ID's due
- June 15 – all market/breeding sheep, market/breeding meat goat, breeding & feeder calves, bucket calves, swine, rabbits, dairy goat ID's due to the Extension Office.

LIVESTOCK ID/OWNERSHIP REQUIREMENTS FOR SHOWING CLAY COUNTY FAIR ONLY

Pick up tags and Animal Ownership Affidavit (ID) paper forms from the Extension Office. Forms also online at 4h.unl.edu/county-fair/affidavits.

MARKET BEEF, FEEDER CALVES, BUCKET CALVES

- ✓ Tag with a 4-H ear tag or EID tag for market
- ✓ Turn in completed ID form

BREEDING BEEF

- ✓ Tattoo number in ear
- ✓ Turn in completed ID form
- ✓ Turn in Breed Association paper

SHEEP, MEAT GOATS

- ✓ Scrapies Tag (or tag 4-H ear tag)
- ✓ Turn in completed ID form

SWINE

- ✓ Universal ear notches
- ✓ Turn in completed ID form

DAIRY GOAT

- ✓ Turn in completed ID form

RABBITS

- ✓ Tattoo in ear
- ✓ Turn in completed ID form

HORSE

- ✓ Turn in completed ID form
- ✓ Complete Advancement Level 1 to show at fair

ID/OWNERSHIP REQUIREMENTS FOR STATE FAIR AND/OR AKSARBEN

****Youth will enter their own animals and make payment into the Showstock Livestock Database.**

Pick up tags and DNA envelopes from Ext. office. Youth participating in the State Fair will have until Aug. 10 to select whether they are showing animals 4-H or FFA.

ALL MARKET ANIMALS - BEEF, SHEEP, SWINE, & MEAT GOAT

- ✓ Market beef, tagged with an EID & DNA sample envelope
- ✓ Swine tagged with EID & DNA sample
- ✓ Market sheep and meat goats use USDA scrapie tag number for ID & DNA sample
- ✓ Submit DNA sample to the Ext. Office
- ✓ Enter animal information and payment (\$7 per animal) into online Showstockmgr.com livestock database
- ✓ Obtain Premise ID from Nebraska Dept. of Ag and submit it to the Ext. office.

BREEDING BEEF, SHEEP, MEAT GOATS

- ✓ Breeding beef must have tattoo as ID. Breed registration papers submitted to Ext. Office.
- ✓ Breeding sheep and meat goats use USDA scrapie tag number for ID.
- ✓ Submit animal information into online Showstockmgr.com livestock database \$2
