- 2. The 4-H Horse Superintendent will be notified at entry time, or in case of emergency, if any changes are necessary.
- 3. All exhibitors must have completed Horse Advancement Level 1 to compete in fair events.
- 4. Only members are allowed to ride horses during show times. Adults may not warm up horses.
