Tractor & Equipment Safety Certification Course – Wednesday, June 7th

Teens 14 or 15 years of age who work on farms, or others who are interested in learning about safe farming practices, are encouraged to register for the certification course. Students under age 14 are not eligible for certifications but the hands-on events are open to everyone in the community. Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.


- Cost is \$35.00 and is paid at the time of the driving exam

Youth must complete the first day of the course either by attending a hands-on event or online. The hands-on events will take place May 22 in North Platte and May 30th in Grand Island. After completing the hands-on event, and testing, the required driving test will be offered at 7 locations across Nebraska in the month of May & June.

- Onsite training includes equipment operation and ATV safety lessons. Youth must demonstrate competence in hitching and unhitching equipment and driving a tractor and trailer through a course.
- In-person training in West Point will be held at the Cuming County Fairgrounds


