TRACTOR & EQUIPMENT SAFETY TRAINING – Tuesday, May 28 & Wednesday, May 29

Certification from this course allows 14- and 15-year-olds to legally drive a tractor and do fieldwork with certain equipment.

- Cost is \$40.00 and is paid online

 - **Certification Day #1** – 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. (Nielsen Community Center)
 - **Certification Day #2** – 8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. (Cuming County Fairgrounds)

Certification is earned by completing a hands-on safety day with a written test (Day #1), then completing the Tractor & Equipment Safety Training with driving exam (Day #2). Anyone 14 and older can attend. Youth under 14 can attend Certification Day #1 if accompanied by an adult, at no charge.

- Onsite training includes equipment operation and safety lessons. Youth must demonstrate competence in hitching and unhitching equipment and driving a tractor and trailer through a course.

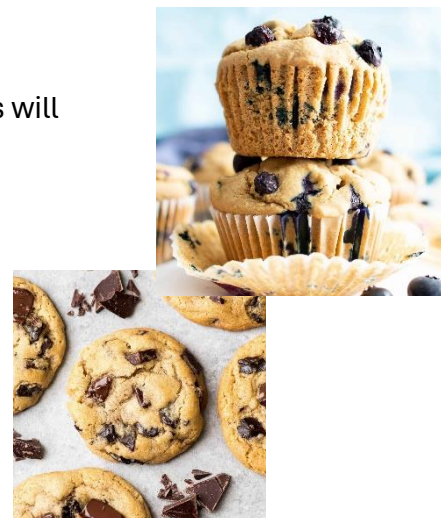


BAKING FOR BEGINNERS - Monday, July 8
