

# 2024 Cuming County 4-H Workshop Schedule



## TRACTOR & EQUIPMENT SAFETY TRAINING-Tuesday, May 28 & Wednesday, May 29

Certification from this course allows 14- and 15-year-olds to legally drive a tractor and do fieldwork with certain equipment.

- Cost is \$40.00 and is paid online

  - Certification Day #1 8:00 a.m. 4:30 p.m. (Nielsen Community Center)
  - Certification Day # 2 8:00 a.m. 3:00 p.m. (Cuming County Fairgrounds)

Certification is earned by completing a hands-on safety day with a written test (Day #1), then completing the Tractor & Equipment Safety Training with driving exam (Day #2). Anyone 14 and older can attend. Youth under 14 can attend Certification Day #1 if accompanied by an adult, at no charge.

 Onsite training includes equipment operation and safety lessons. Youth must demonstrate competence in hitching and unhitching equipment and driving a tractor and trailer through a course.

## **CORNHOLE BOARDS – Thursday, May 30 & Friday, May 31**

In this workshop, youth will put their woodworking skills to the test! For day 1, youth will learn how to read woodworking plans, cut, and assemble their cornhole boards. On Day 2, youth will complete their project with stain. This workshop is open to Cuming County 4-H members.
