## STEAM Clothing 2: Simply Sewing

For requirements related to exhibits see clothing entries in the fair book.

- Dress (not formal wear)
- Romper or Jumpsuit
$\square$ Two Piece Skirted Outfit - skirt w/top, vest or lined/unlined jacket. Must have sewn two pieces
$\square$ Jumper and Shirt - must have sewn both pieces
**Purchased top can be worn to complete a skirt, pants, or short outfit.
$\square$ Two Piece Pants or Shorts Outfit - pants or short w/top, vest or lined/unlined jacket - must have sewn two pieces
$\square$ * Bottom (pants or shorts)
-     * Lined/Unlined Jacket
$\square$ * Nightshirt OR nightgown OR pajamas OR robe

## STEAM Clothing 3: A Stitch Further

Pant Outfit - pants or shorts w/shirt, vest or lined/unlined jacket
