

DEPT G – DAIRY CATTLE

Judge: Leah Estrela, St Libory NE

Purple award \$8; blue award \$6; red award, \$5; and white award \$4 (\$1 less if grade cattle)

Dairy exhibitors may be required to produce their registration certificates or 4-H Dairy Identification Certificate to the superintendent.

A dairy exhibitor may exhibit a maximum of three cows and three heifer dairy animals.

Milking cows will be released immediately following the Dairy Show on Thursday. All non-milking dairy will be required to remain on the grounds until release time on Sunday. The Grand and Reserve Overall Champions must return by 12:00 noon on Sunday and stay until release time. This will apply to FFA cows as well.

Showmanship (Note: Pre-Entry is required)

All showmanship participants must fill out exhibitor entry cards to participate in showmanship. Failure to do so will forfeit their competition in showmanship.

35-40-9A Junior Division – 8, 9, 10, 11 on January 1 of current year
35-40-9B Intermediate Division – 12, 13, 14 on January 1 of current year
35-40-9C Senior Division – 15 and over on January 1 of current year.

Championships

All cattle considered for championships must be blue ribbon or purple ribbon quality.

Heifer classes will compete for Junior Champion trophy and Junior Reserve Champion rosette.

Junior Champion and Junior Reserve Champion and Senior Champions and Reserve Champion of each breed will compete for Champion and Reserve Champion rosettes of the respective breeds.

Each Champion and Reserve Champion of each breed will compete for Grand and Reserve Grand Champion of the dairy show.

Animal born after April 30, 2017 are not eligible to show in individual classes or in Dairy Herds.

Registered and Grades will show together.

Junior Dairy Herd

Exhibitors in the Dairy Herd Class will enter three females. At least one of the three must be a cow that has freshened and completed a 305 day M.E. and all three must be of the same breed. Production records to be used for scoring in the Junior Dairy Herd must meet the same criteria as those listed for the Dairy Production Awards. No exceptions will be made. Animals entered in the crossbred section are not eligible for junior dairy herd awards. A mixed herd is considered as a grade herd. A herd containing both 4-H and FFA animals cannot qualify. Herds will be scored and awarded ribbons on the basis of the current years Dairy Herd Score Card. Each exhibitors is expected to fill out their own score card and present it when cattle are checked in with production verified by the superintendent.

Senior yearlings that have freshened must show in the 2-year old class.

Dairy Production Award

1. Awards will be presented on the basis of 305 2X ME records in progress for cows in milk and on the basis of the most recently completed 305 2X ME record for dry cows.
2. Exhibitors should provide DHIA herd identification and DHIA cow identification on entry form. Animal may qualify on either milk or protein. Exhibitors must furnish the show management with production information at the time animals are checked in.
3. The show management will verify the production information on the entry form and clerk sheets.
4. Animals entered in the crossbred section are not eligible for production awards.

A special ribbon will be awarded to each cow that meets the following production requirements:
