

DEPT G – POULTRY

Judge: Cole Meador, Lincoln NE

Purple award \$2.00; blue award \$1.50; red award \$1.00; white award \$0.50

A club member may have 10 entries, in addition to showmanship. All entry tags must be made prior to fair, similar to all other livestock entries. Birds may arrive from 5:00-9:00 p.m. on Wednesday, Birds must be removed by 10:00 p.m. on Sunday. All birds entered singly are not eligible for part of a trio. Birds entered in a trio are not eligible to be judged as an individual. Classes may be divided according to age and possibly sex. Ducks will be divided into market and purebred. All birds will be checked for lice and mites before entry. Exhibits will be rejected if infested. Bring your own clean milk jugs for feeders and waterers and bring feed in neat covered buckets. Poultry will be judged on Herdsmanship.

4-Hers must be present with 4-H t-shirt or 4-H emblem on a white shirt during the judging of exhibits.
