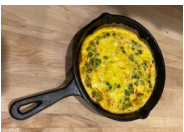

What: Learn how plants grow in a desert environment and construct your very own desert garden that meets 4-H guidelines.

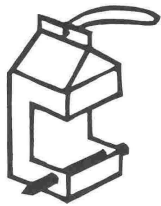
