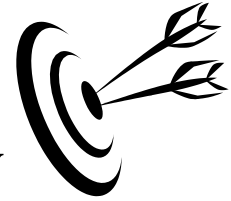

Dress Code

Blue Denim Jeans and choice of the following:
White shirt with 4-H chevron (Chevron available at Extension Office.)
Custer County 4-H T-Shirt
4-H Club Shooting Shirt

Footwear must completely cover the foot.
(Unacceptable foot wear include: sandals, clogs, crocks, flip flops, and bare feet.)

Ribbons and medals will be presented for this competition.
Awards will be handed out at the 4-H Awards Presentation during the County Fair.
Failure to follow the rules may result in loss of ribbon placing.

The following are the archery classes and shooting distances which will be used for this match:

- Freestyle Limited Recurve (FSLR) - Longbow or recurve that **MUST BE SHOT WITH FINGERS**. Sights without magnification and stabilizers are allowed.
Shooting Distance:
Cubs – 10 yards
Youth – 20 yards
Young Adults – 20 yards
- Basic Bow (BB) - Compound, Recurve/Long Bow or Genesis that **MUST BE SHOT WITH FINGERS**. No sights allowed.
Shooting Distance:
Cubs – 10 yards
Youth – 10 yards
Young Adults – 20 yards
- Freestyle Limited (FSL) - Any compound bow that **MUST BE SHOT WITH FINGERS**. Sights, stabilizers and peep sights are allowed.
Shooting Distance:
Cubs – 10 yards
Youth – 20 yards
Young Adults – 20 yards
- Freestyle (FS) - Same as Freestyle Limited, except **MUST BE SHOT WITH A MECHANICAL RELEASE**.
Shooting Distance:
Cubs – 10 yards
Youth – 20 yards
Young Adults – 20 yards
- Bowhunter Freestyle (BHFS) - Same as Freestyle except stabilizer cannot exceed 12 inches, pin sights only (no magnification). **SIGHTS CANNOT BE ADJUSTED AFTER THE FIRST SCORING ARROW**.
Shooting Distance:
Cubs – 10 yards
Youth – 20 yards
Young Adults – 20 yards
