PILLOW POWER I



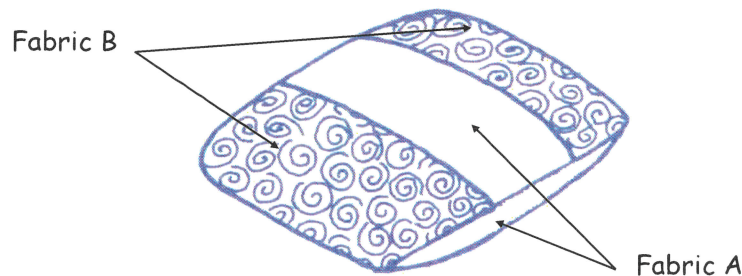
Who: Boys and girls ages 9 through 13, who have never participated in a June Jamboree Pillow Power class.

What: Learn beginning sewing techniques. Sew a striped pillow, plus one other simple item.

When: Monday, June 10 - Wednesday, June 12, 9:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon

Where: 4-H Building, Broken Bow

What To Bring: *Fabric*...1 yard of 100% cotton fabric for the pillow back and 1 of the stripes on the pillow front (Fabric A), 1/2 yard of 100% cotton fabric of coordinating fabric for the other 2 stripes on the pillow front (Fabric B). See pillow diagram below. Fabric should be at least 45" wide. Do not purchase one-way (directional) print fabric or border print fabric. *Required sewing tools*...sewing machine (due to the large amount of sewing and colors of thread used, participants will be unable to share sewing machines), thread to match fabric, pins, pin cushion, seam gauge, seam ripper, and sewing shears.



Preshrink your fabrics by washing them in hot water. Since they are all going to be used in the same pillow, you can preshrink them together. You don't need to use detergent. Dry in the dryer at normal setting. Just before the fabrics are dry, remove from dryer, straighten, and press.

Who: Boys and girls ages 9 through 13, who have never participated in a June Jamboree Pillow Power class.



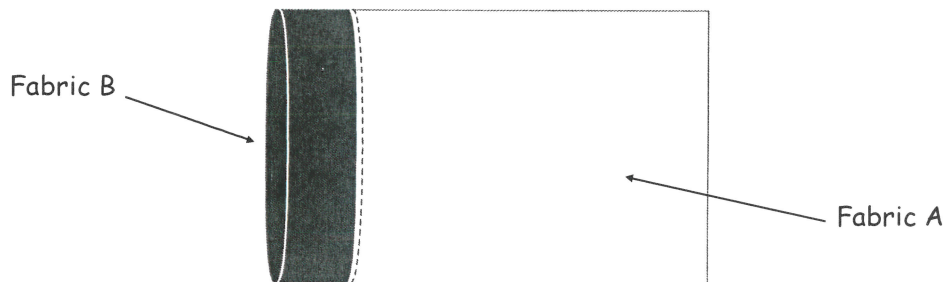
What: Learn beginning sewing techniques. Sew a pillowcase, plus one additional item.

When: Monday, June 10 - Wednesday, June 12, 1:30 to 4:00 p.m. each day
Where: 4-H Building, Broken Bow

What To Bring:

Fabric...1 yard of 100% cotton fabric for the pillow body (Fabric A) and 1/2 yard of 100% cotton fabric of coordinating fabric for the pillowcase band (Fabric B). See diagram below. Fabric should be at least 45" wide. Do not purchase one-way (directional) print fabric or border print fabric.

Required sewing tools...sewing machine (due to the large amount of sewing and colors of thread used, participants will be unable to share sewing machines), bobbin which fits sewing machine, thread to match fabric, pins, pin cushion, extra sewing machine needles, seam gauge, seam ripper, and sewing shears.



Preshrink your fabrics by washing them in hot water. Since they are all going to be used in the same pillow, you can preshrink them together. You don't need to use detergent. Dry in the dryer at normal setting. Just before the fabrics are dry, remove from dryer, straighten, and press.

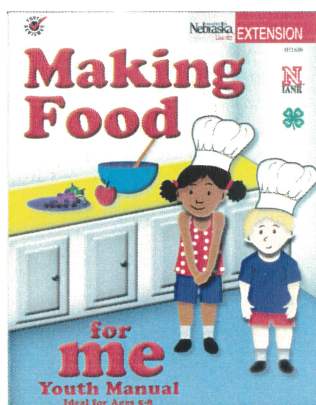

What: Youth will learn about the structure of a tree, how each part functions to help the tree grow, and how to identify what has happened in the life of a tree.

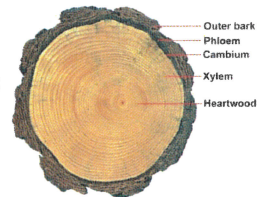
