

A bill of sale will only be accepted for FAIR ANIMALS under the conditions that it is ENTIRELY FILLED OUT.

Animals that do NOT have a brand STILL NEED a properly executed Bill of Sale filled out from where that animal originated from.

Every blank on the Bill of Sale must be completed.

IF THE BILL OF SALE IS NOT ENTIRELY FILLED OUT AS STATED BELOW & DISPLAYED ON THE EXAMPLE PROVIDED- THE BILL OF SALE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AT CHECK IN.

The Bill of Sale is required as part of Custer County Fair check-in.

EVERY blank must be completed.

- Brand Owner (Seller) & Physical Address
- Date (Month, Day, & Year) of Sale
- 4-H/FFA Kid Name & Physical Address
- Number of Head
- Description of Cattle (sex, breed, color, age)
- Brand & Brand Location
- Filling in the 'Price per Head' & 'Total Purchase Price' is to your discretion (an 'x' is sufficient)
- Signature of the Seller (Brand Owner)
- Witness Signature to the Seller Signature
- "YES" or "NO" written on the BEEF CHECKOFF FEE PAID line

To comply with the law, all blanks provided must be completed in full. There must be at least one witness to seller's signature. This Bill of Sale certifies ownership, but it does not exempt owner from a brand inspection on all cattle prior to their removal from The Nebraska Brand Inspection Area.
