

Custer County Market Beef Weigh-In

Saturday, February 3, 2024

Following is a map of how we would like to have everyone pull into the **Broken Bow Animal Hospital** (44104 Memorial Dr.) to unload, process, and reload the calves. As you can see, we have included a table on recommended times for you to be at the veterinary clinic to weigh-in your calves. This is our attempt to distribute the various families so that everyone will not show up at the same time.

Explanation of Map:

1. **Pulling into veterinary clinic.** ****Please enter Broken Bow Animal Hospital from the SOUTH**** When you pull into the clinic, proceed towards the west fence and get lined up with the trailer unloading and reloading area.
2. **Extra Trailer parking.** There is room to park 3-4 trailers that can wait their turn to unload/reload.
3. **Path to back up.** You will be backing towards the two poles that have red and white reflector tape on them.
4. **Trailer unloading area.** It is our plan to leave you backed up while we process the calves and then you can reload. It will be important if you are waiting to unload to stay in your vehicle so that you can back up as soon as the loaded trailer pulls away.
5. **Extra Trailer Parking.** There is room to park 3-4 trailers along the North side of our driveway. Be sure to pull ahead far enough so you don't block the view of trailers leaving.

SAFETY!! Please Enter Broken Bow Animal Hospital from the SOUTH. Everyone needs to take extra caution when pulling back out onto the county road. Cars can come around the corner from the North at a rapid pace. Be careful when pulling out onto blacktop.

It is our plan to have all the necessary help to expedite the unloading, processing, and reloading in a timely manner.

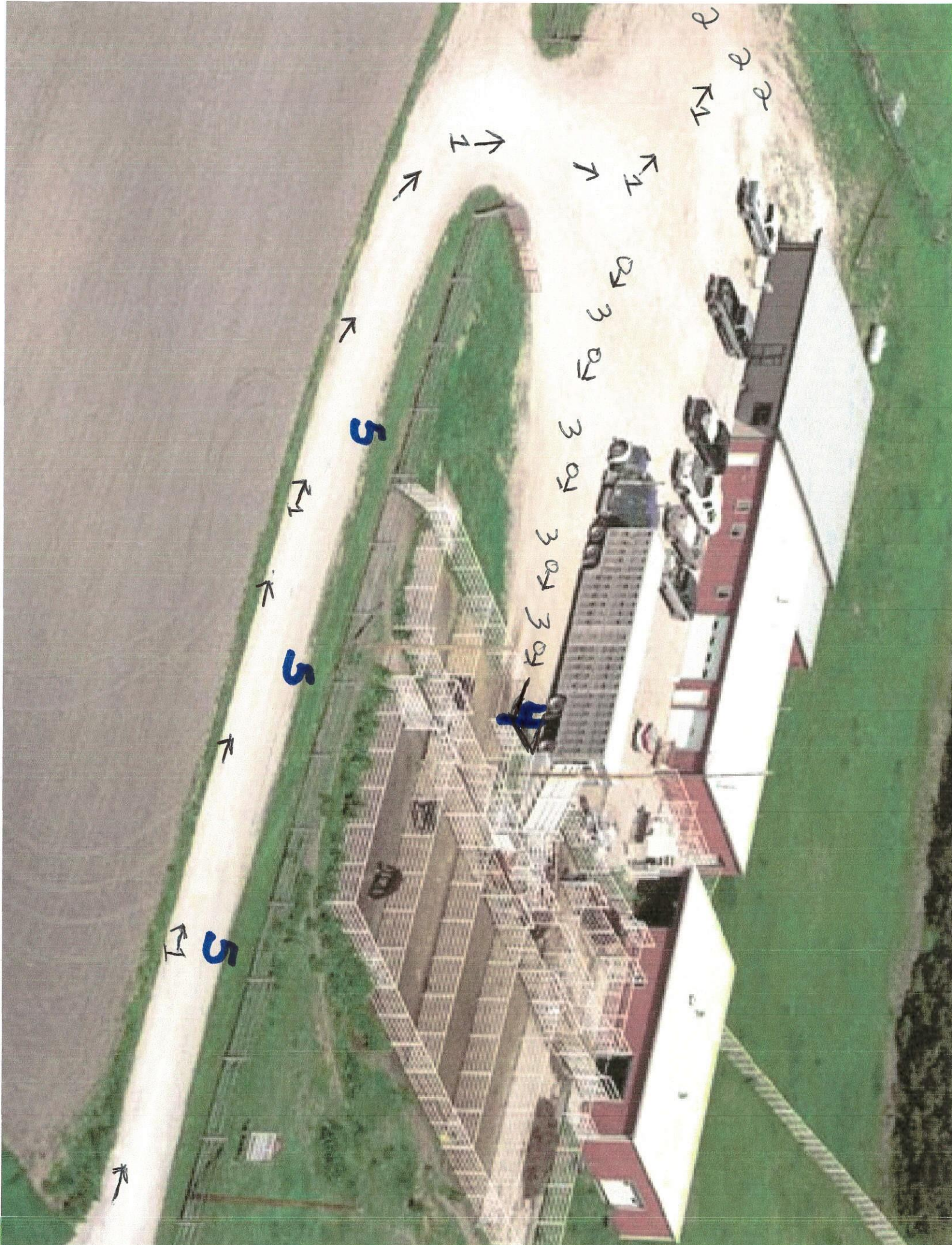
