4-H Rabbit, Poultry, and Pigeon Exhibitors,

Show programs will be available online at https://go.unl.edu/programs.

Rabbit and Poultry exhibitors should bring a broom, dustpan, feed, feed pans, wood chips, water bowls and/or water bottles for your animals. Since we have moved to Barn 5, water bowls will be allowed to be used. You may also bring fans or other methods to keep your animals cool. For watering your animals and cleaning water or feed bowls, you may **NOT** use the restrooms, drinking fountain, or the water hydrant by the south doors of Barn 5. Use the hydrant between Barns 4 & 5.

Be sure to bring two padlocks for each rabbit cage. There is a freezer to freeze water bottles for rabbits. Be sure to bring a labelled sack to keep your bottles in.

When checking in rabbits, pigeons, and poultry on Sunday evening July 28th, please use the north door of Barn 5 to avoid the traffic and trailers from the large animal check-in.

Barn 5 (rabbit, pigeon, and poultry building) will open at 7:00 a.m. each morning and close at 8:00 p.m.

There are a lot of windows in Barn 5. These can be opened or closed as needed for the comfort of the animals. Please remember that not all rabbits are housed outside at the 4-Her's homes, so please work with other exhibitors to regulate the wind and sun getting to the rabbits. The windows will be closed at night for the safety of the animals.

It is requested that you not use the paper towels from the restrooms to clean up your rabbit cages and any messes that your rabbits make. If you are wanting to use paper towels, please bring paper towels with you to the county fair. The paper towels in the restrooms are for the public to use when using the restrooms.

There will be no washing of poultry allowed in Barn 5.

Tuesday, July 30th: 4-H Rabbit Show 8:30 a.m. with the Poultry and Pigeon Shows following the rabbit show.
