



## Dawson County Shooting Sports

Dawson County Shooting Sports is a program sponsored by UNL Extension in Dawson County and the National Shooting Sports program. The program complies with all national and state rules and regulations. The program is administered in Nebraska by a nationally certified state committee consisting of extension staff and volunteers. The program is designed to: 1) give youth instruction and training in the safe use of firearms; 2) enhance self-confidence, personal development, responsibility, and sportsmanship; 3) create an appreciation and understanding of natural resources; and 4) provide volunteer instructors with instruction and information on how to plan and manage shooting sport training.

All youth in Dawson County who wish to participate in this project must be trained by a certified shooting sports instructor who is certified in the discipline the youth is registered for. The disciplines available for the 2022 4-H year are: 1) BB Gun, 2) Air Rifle, 3) Air Pistol, 4) Archery, 5) .22 rifle 6) Shotgun and 7) Hunting Skills.

Please contact an instructor to participate in their club trainings and activities. It is important that arrangements are made ahead of time so that instructors know how many youth to expect. One of these two clubs must be listed as your primary or secondary club on the enrollment.
